Is life getting better in Nicaragua?

...yes, undoubtedly, for some but not for the 75 plus percent of the population that need it the most. In the 12 years since my first visit to Nicaragua, improvements can be seen with regard to roads and buildings but as far as the day to day struggle for basic existence by the above segment, there has only been very minor improvements; daily existence still being an ongoing struggle. The annual income of this group of the population is between US\$500.00 and US\$1,000.00/year. I wish that after this 12th Journey, I could be more optimistic with regard to the future of this population group and, hopefully, I will be proven wrong in my long term assessment, nothing could please me more.

On this trip the focus was on 5 Senior Care Facilities, 2 Lower Level Schools, 2 Families and 4 Individuals. Each Senior Care Facility received 100Lbs of Beans, Rice, Sugar and 6 - 2.5Kg of Powdered Milk. For the Schools, we purchased Dictionaries, Atlases and Solar Powered Calculators some of which still need to be delivered by my sources in Nicaragua.

The contents of 4 Suitcases/Roller Boards was, likewise, distributed to the below listed entities. Again, a special <u>Thank You to Continental Airlines</u> for their cooperation in getting these items to Nicaragua.
